

# Beginner's Sewing

## BURRITO PILLOWCASE

### CLASS DESCRIPTION:

The first class will be learn to sew a burrito pillowcases. This is a really fun technique and only takes a short time to make. You will need main fabric, trim and a 2 inch width piece for accent. You can use a sewing machine or later on your serger. Make a new set of pillowcases for your bed or stitch some for gifts. Make out of cotton or flannel for winter. Come learn some machine basics also, what needle and thread to use, the accuracy of a ¼ inch foot and more in the company of others.

### SUPPLY LIST:

Fabric

- 3/4 yard (27" x width of fabric from selvage to selvage) of the main fabric
- 1/4 yard (9" x width of fabric from selvage to selvage) of coordinating fabric for the cuff
- 2" x width of fabric (from selvage to selvage) strip of solid fabric for accent, pressed in half lengthwise to make a 1" folded strip

### SEWING BOX/KIT THAT INCLUDES:

\_\_\_\_\_ Thread (100% cotton or polyester) neutral or complementary color to your fabric

\_\_\_\_\_ ¼" foot

\_\_\_\_\_ Bobbin wound with thread same as top thread

\_\_\_\_\_ SHARP scissors

\_\_\_\_\_ Seam Ripper

\_\_\_\_\_ Fabric Glue

\_\_\_\_\_ Cutting mat, rotary cutter with new blade, and rotary ruler (various sizes)

\_\_\_\_\_ Needles and neutral thread (50# cotton or polyester) and matching thread

\_\_\_\_\_ Sharp straight pins and pin cushion
