

Materials List for T Shirt Quilt Class

Rotary Mat and Rotary Cutter

Rotary Ruler 6 1/2 x 24

Square Omnigrd 12 1/2 or 15 1/2 if you have one

Fabric Scissors

Ultra Fine Sharpie

Notebook and Pen

Pins

Sewing Machine and 1/4" foot

Neutral color thread for piecing

Optional: Painters tape, Dressmakers cloth tape-measure

T shirts to use in the quilt

If you wish to use stabilizer Pellon SF101, minimum 3yds (Several stabilizers available at Howell's)

It's the cotton backed one, I don't use it unless shirts are really thin but some people feel more comfortable using it

Cotton fabrics for sashing. Approx 3yds. 2 1/2" pre-cut strips and Jelly rolls work really well.

For sashing I use assorted fabrics for a scrappy, unique look and is a great way to use scraps. You can use a single or limited color scheme as desired. 2 1/2" pre-cut strips work great.

To make a queen size quilt using 20 blocks surrounded by fabrics you will need approx 3 yds of fabric for the sashing.

To complete the quilt you will need cotton batting, backing fabric ie. flannel and binding fabric.

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
